Walk to School Week/Month	October 2017	Healthier families; energised children; positive start to their day. Fewer cars being used therefore ease parking problems.
Park and Stride	Refresh/relaunch as part of 10 day active challenge, commencing 09.10.17	Healthier families; energised children; positive start to their day. Fewer cars being used therefore ease parking problems.
Promoting Car Sharing	Autumn term 2017 Launch this at the start of the academic year at parents' information evenings and workshops. Also via newsletters; website?	Fewer cars being used therefore ease parking problems.
Safe driver behaviour and walking routes	Autumn term 2017 Launch this at the start of the academic year at parents' information evenings and workshops. Also via newsletters; website?	Parents park on Pot House Lane and Alpine Road during the school commute. Many parents drive and park on footways creating a safety hazard and an obstruction for those walking. Encourage drivers to think about where they are parking and reduce the problem currently seen around the school. This in turn will encourage others to walk/cycle to school.
Improving public transport information	Spring term 2017	Possible increase in bus use, thus fewer cars?
Road safety education and resources/maps showing safe routes to schools	Spring term 2017	Parents and children more confident to walk, scoot, cycle to school. Share educational DVD to raise awareness of how to use the crossing-road crossing patrol people to attend and speak to whole school in an assembly.
Bike Week	Summer term 2017	Children gain confidence to cycle; healthier children.
Bikeability cycle training	Summer term 2017	Children gain confidence to cycle; healthier children. Parents may feel more confident to allow their child to cycle to school.
Bike storage	Long term	Should more children ride their bikes to school, a bicycle shed with lockable gates could be constructed within the school grounds.





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
