These brothers made a bedroom fort together with mum's permission




Shared Reading

The birds are going to be so grateful for that food. Well done!










Great maths

Such fantastic work from this little boy this week.






Early maths work

This little girl asked for help to make her letters all the same size. Miss Denton sent home the guides we use and just look at her writing now! Fantastic.








Phonics at home

And here's another little girl who did her phonics at home too. Well done you!


















Now that is one great snowman, or snowoman. Or is it a snowboy? Or a snowgirl? Who knows but it's fab.

Fabulous snow angel Miss Rogers. Look at those wings!










And another great snow angel. Eyes closed this time.

Well this little girl decided to find out.








Now that's a snow giant. What big arms you have!










That's one way to get around.
