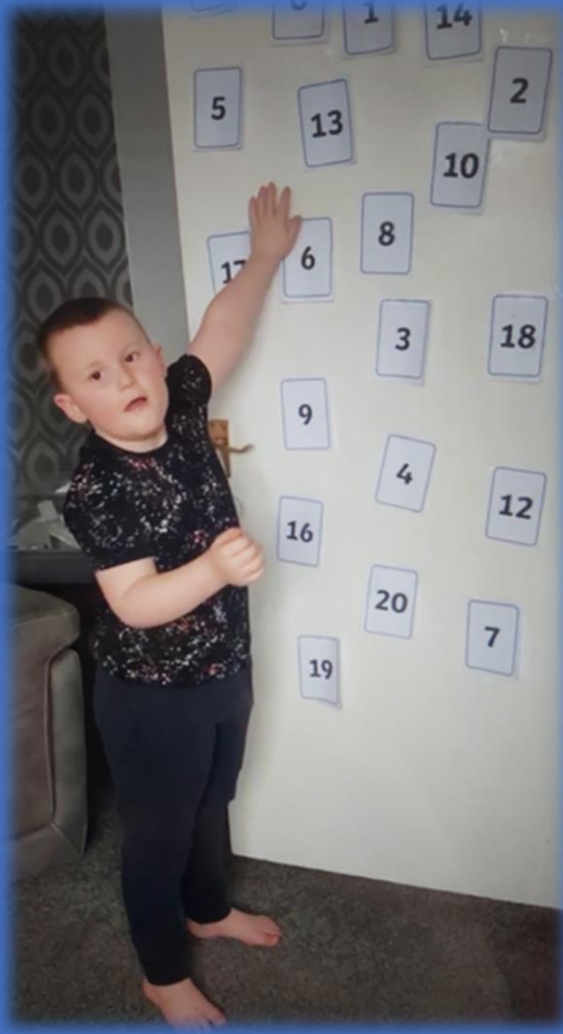

Shared Reading

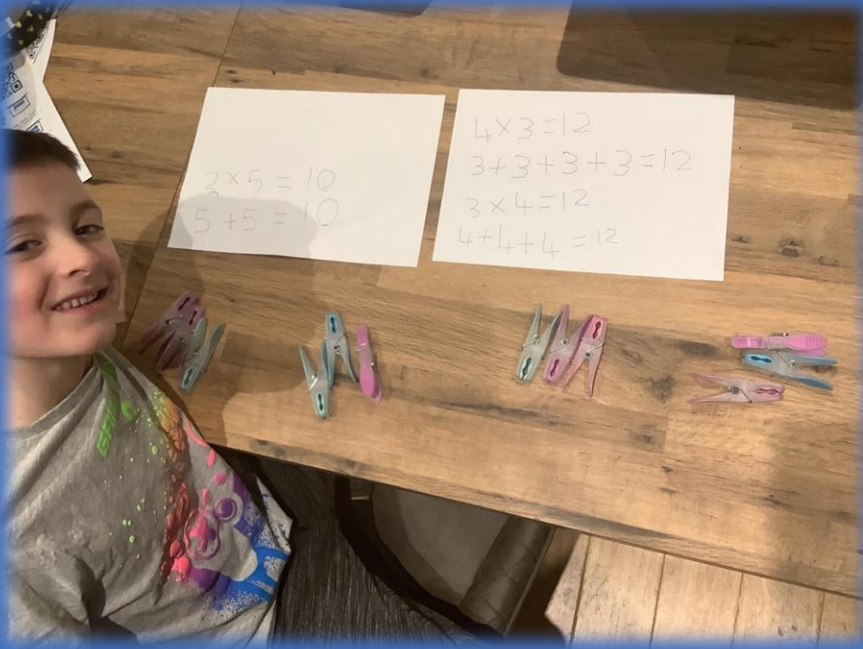
Aether drew a super picture of Crawford the Royal Raven who was in the shared reading story this week. Well done Aether. Fabulous picture.

Feeding the birds

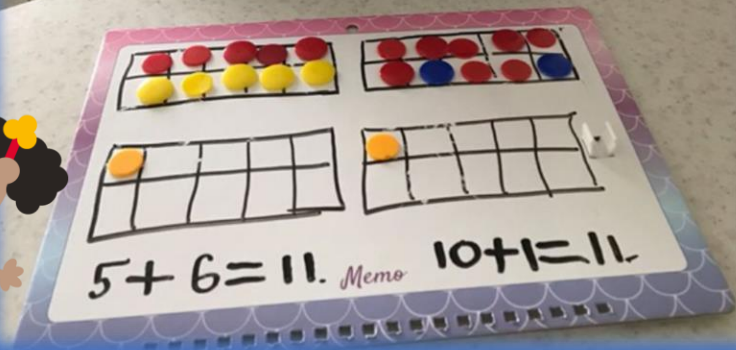
The birds are going to be so grateful for that food. Well done!





Great maths

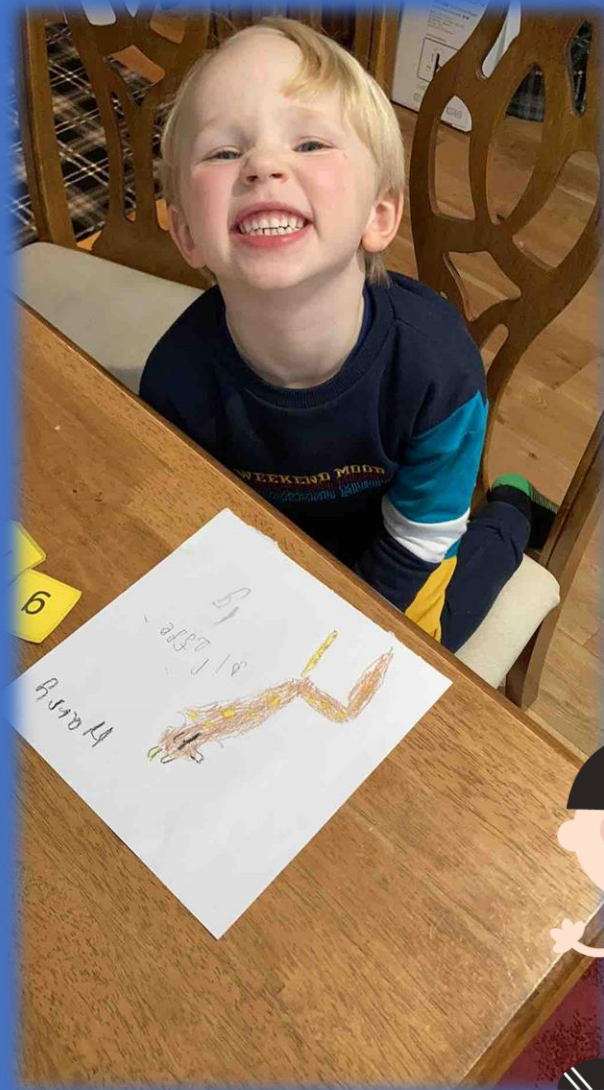
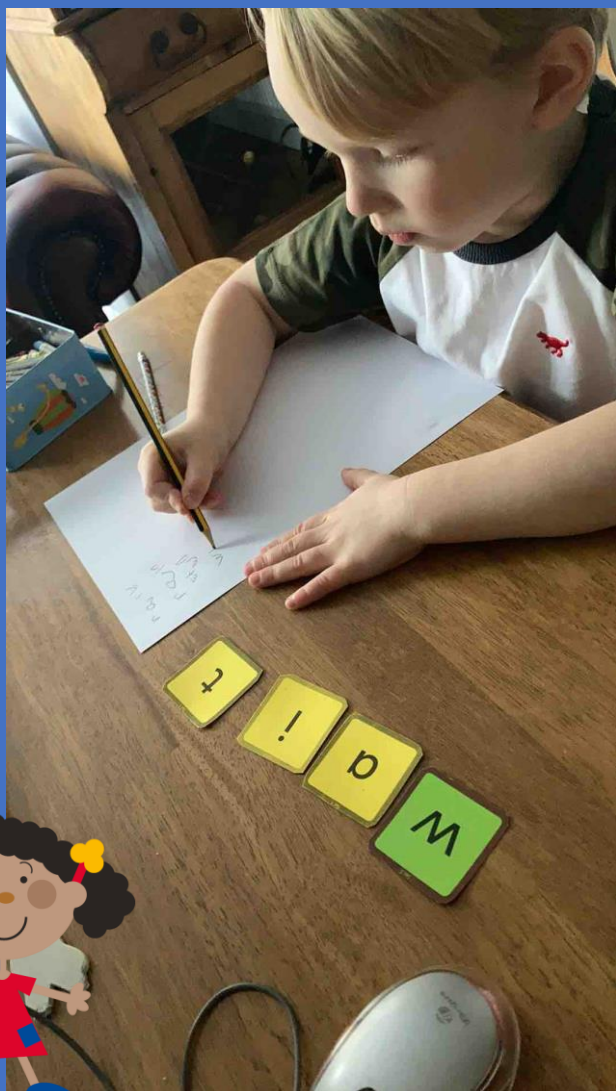

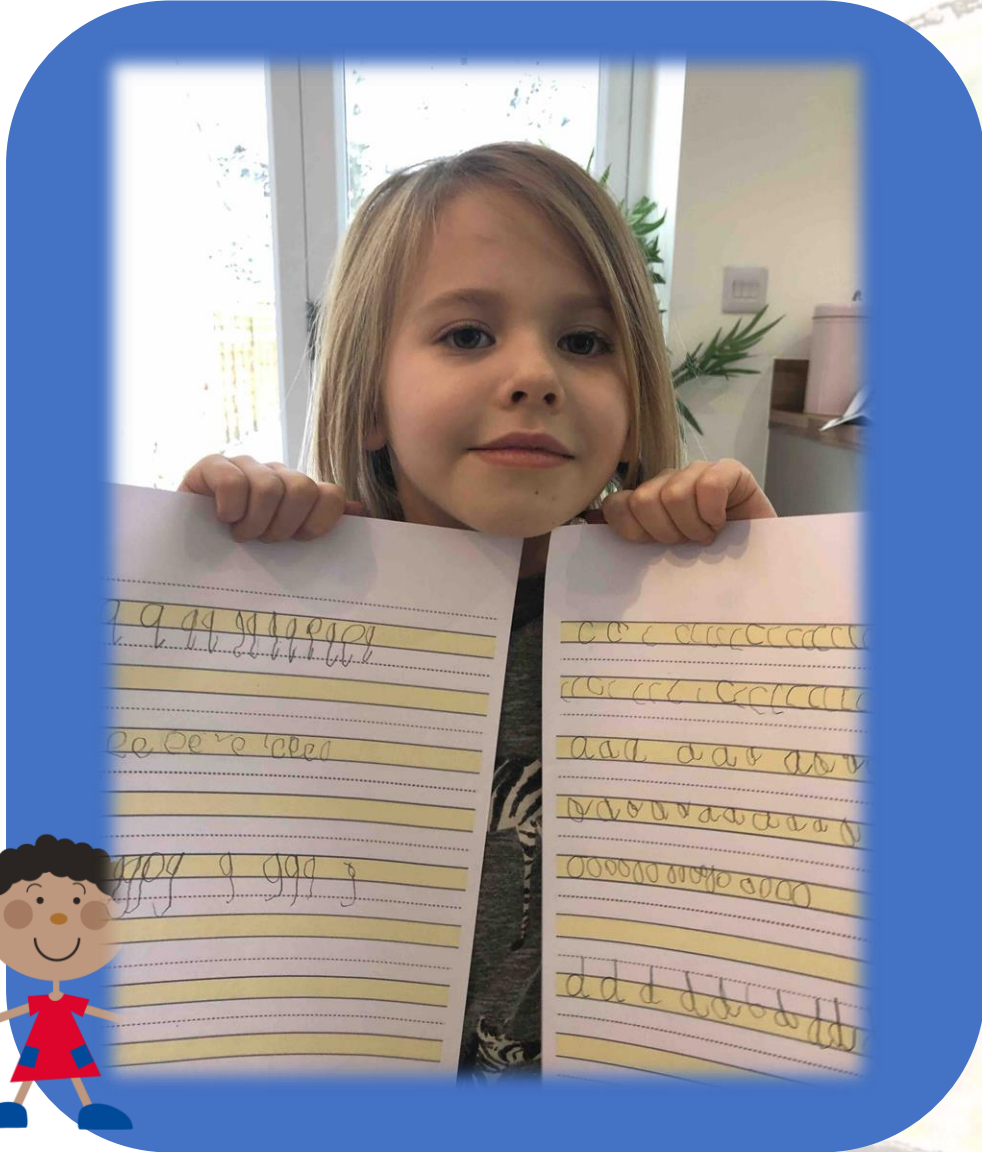
Someone who has tried their absolute best this week. She has completed all her learning and has enjoyed it. She hasn't given up, even when slightly tired.





Fabulous handwriting.

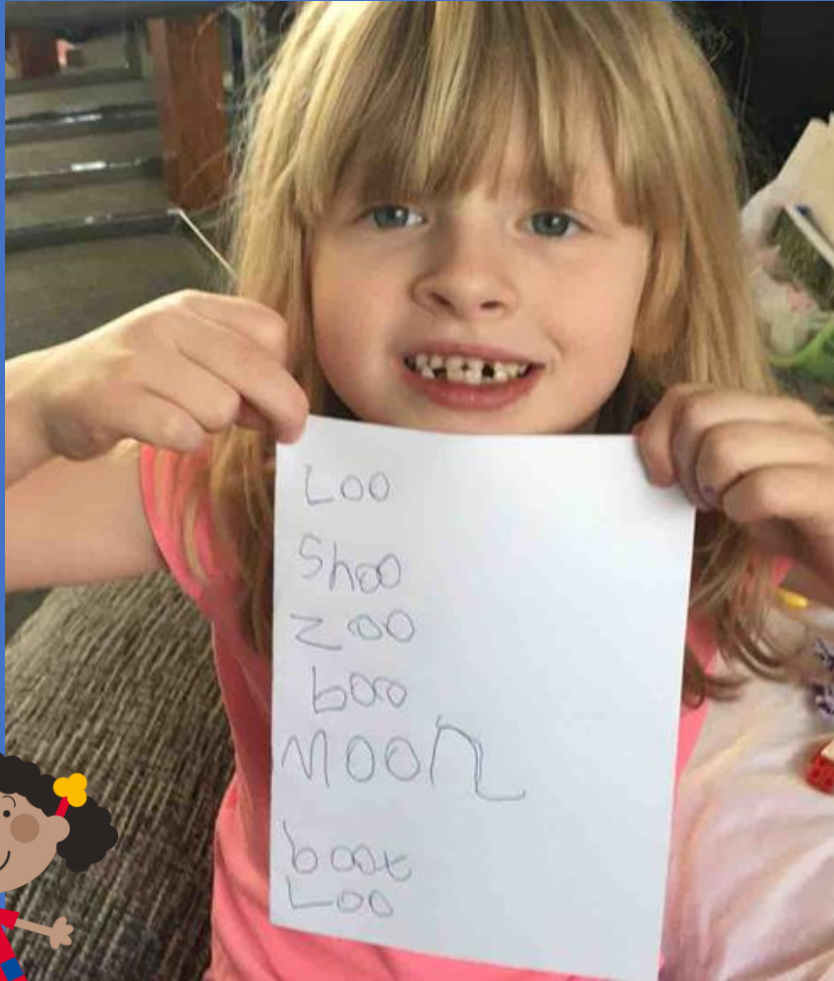
This little girl asked for help to make her letters all the same size. Miss Denton sent home the guides we use and just look at her writing now! Fantastic.

Who said we couldn't teach phonics at home. Well done to this little girl for joining in and doing so well.

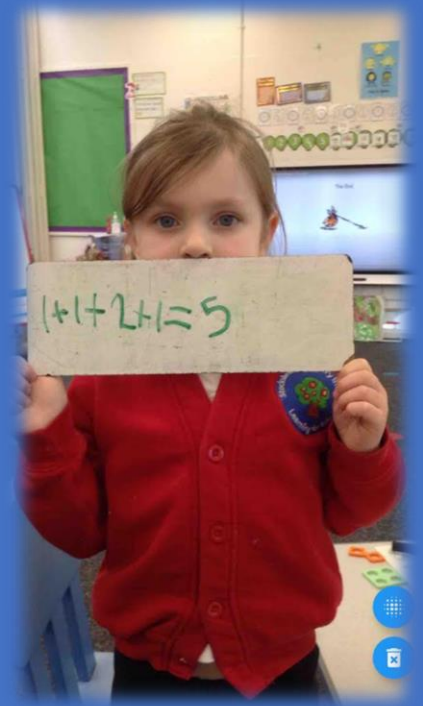
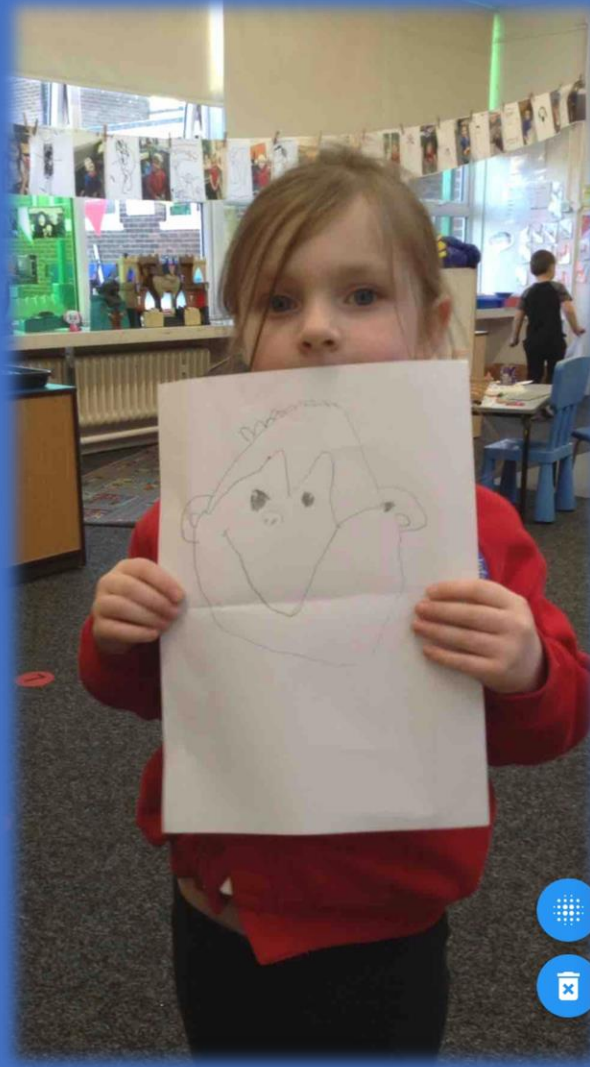
