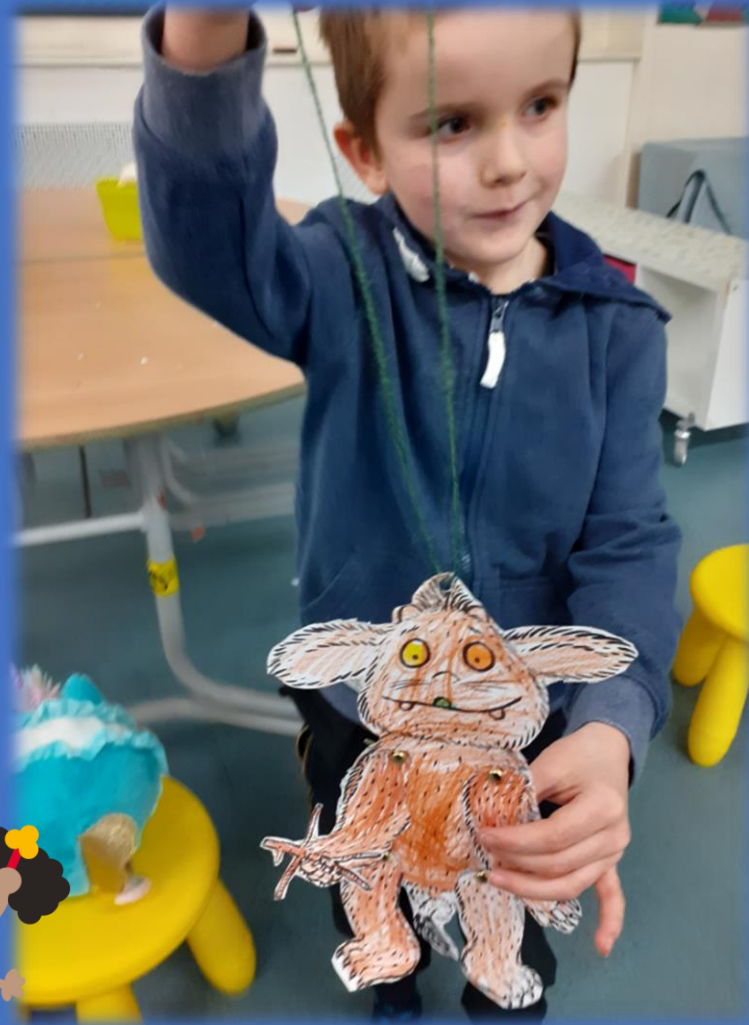
Your name

Writing practise

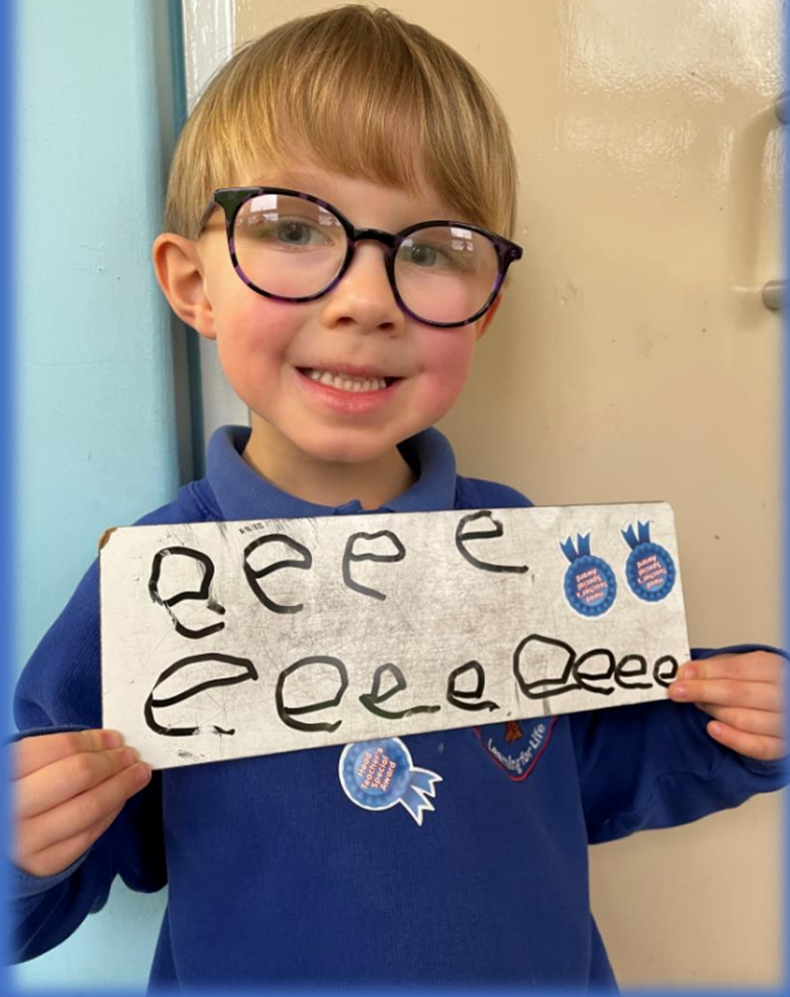
This young man has been a super star learner' this week. He is working very hard in phonics and using what he knows to write words.

A great book.

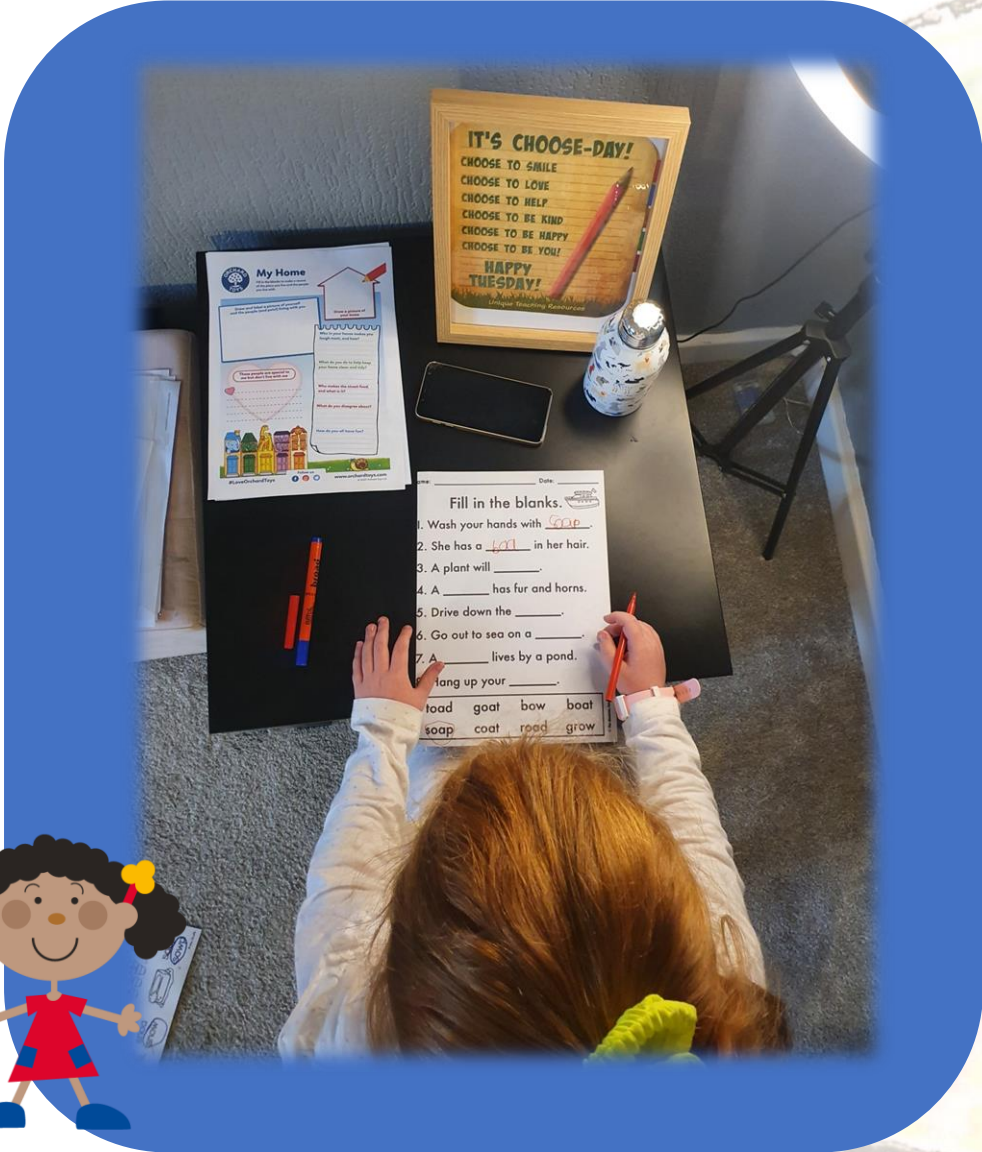
Someone enjoyed this week's story so much they had it again at bedtime.





Very organised!

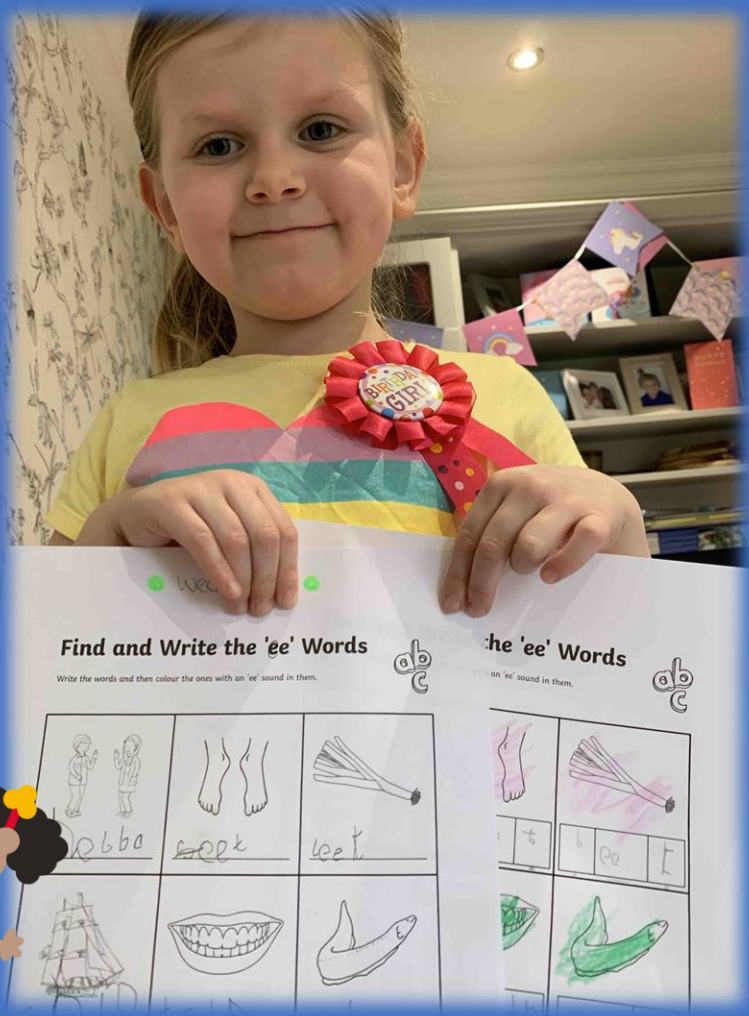
This little girl is doing some amazing home learning at her fabulous work station.

Great blending.

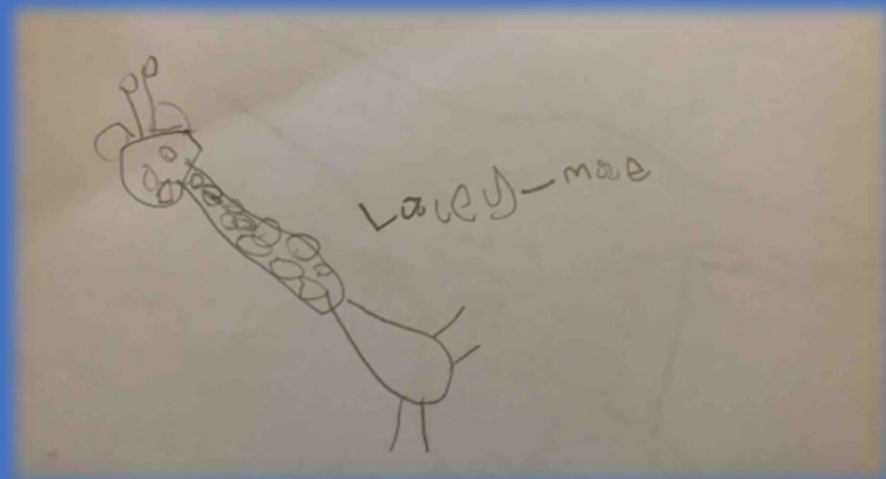
Another super week from this little boy. You should hear him saying the sounds and then blending them to read the words. He's terrific.

Such fun.

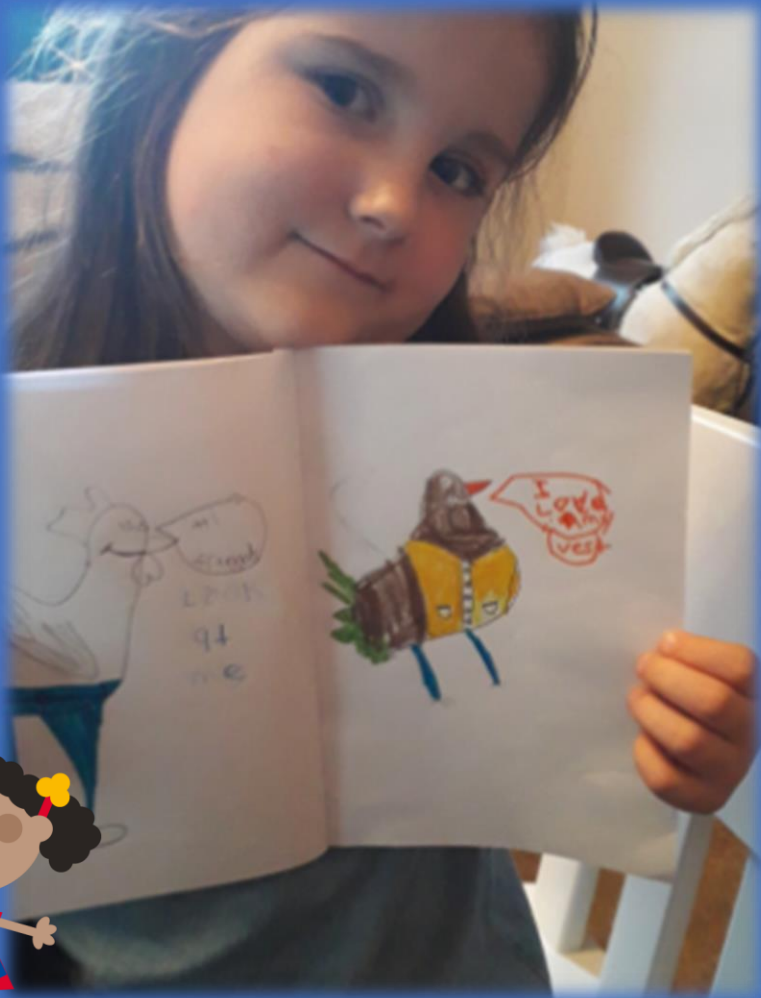
This little boy is doing so much learning at home. He's enjoying it too.





Super rooster

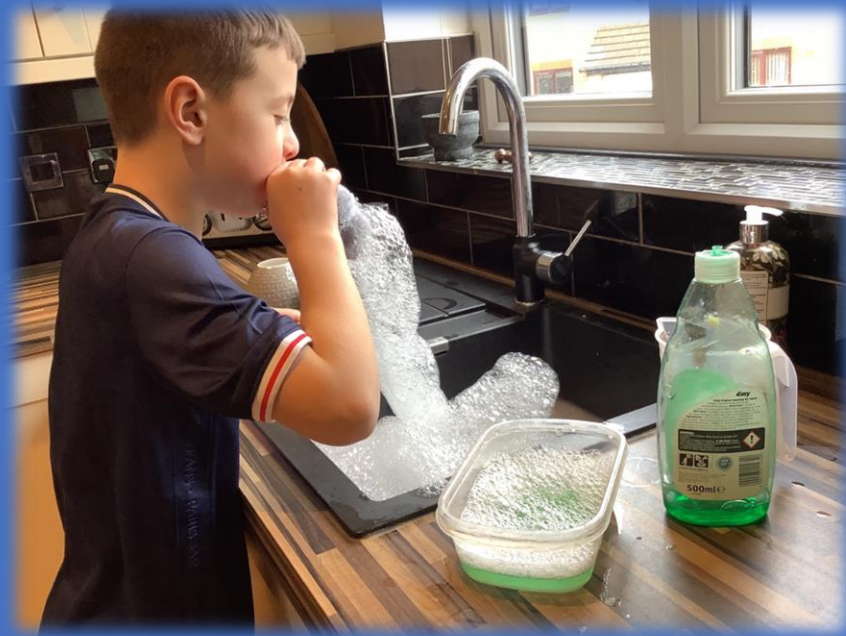
Well done for all the work you've done this week and posted on Seesaw. Your teachers have enjoyed looking at it.

Emily doing PE with Lee.

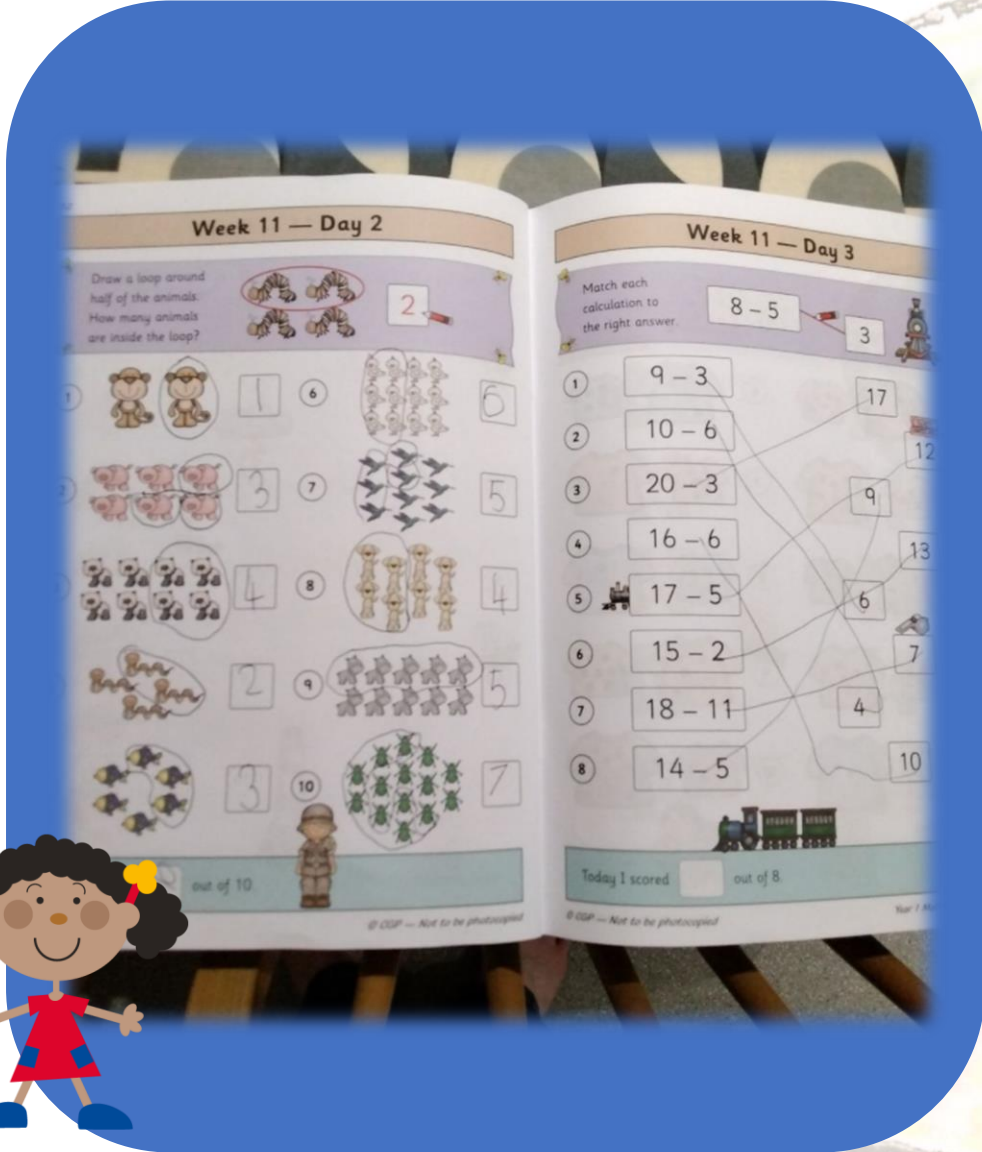
Keeping active and fit is important and Lee always makes it fun. Well done Em, for joining in so well.





Hermione's on fire.

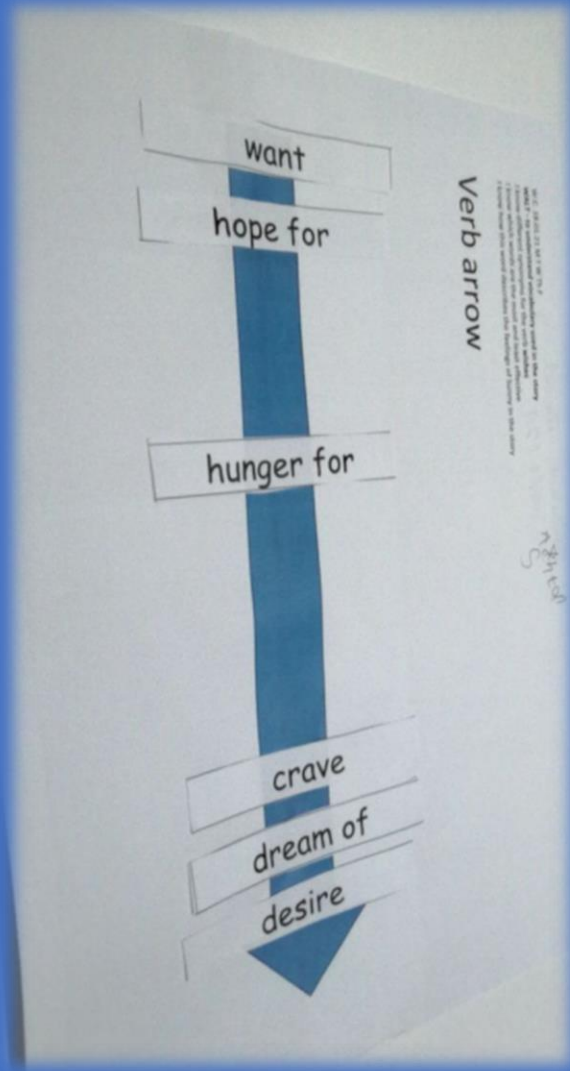
She'll be a maths genius at this rate.
