Super Science

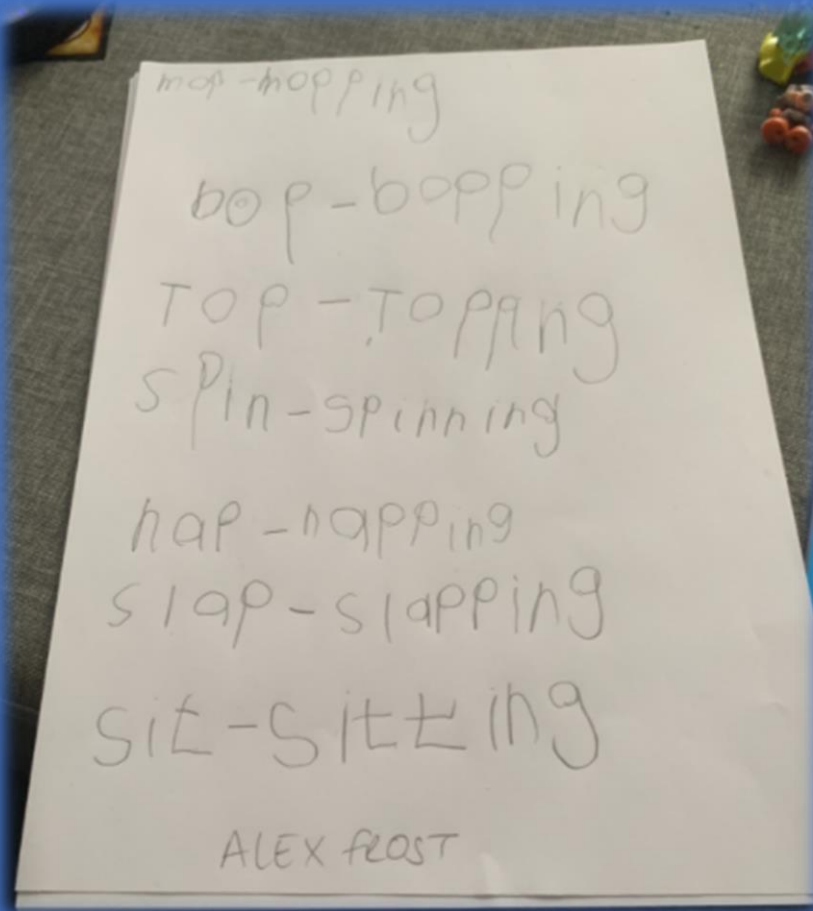
This young man has been doing experiments with his dad this week. Here he is making a tornado!

We're impressed

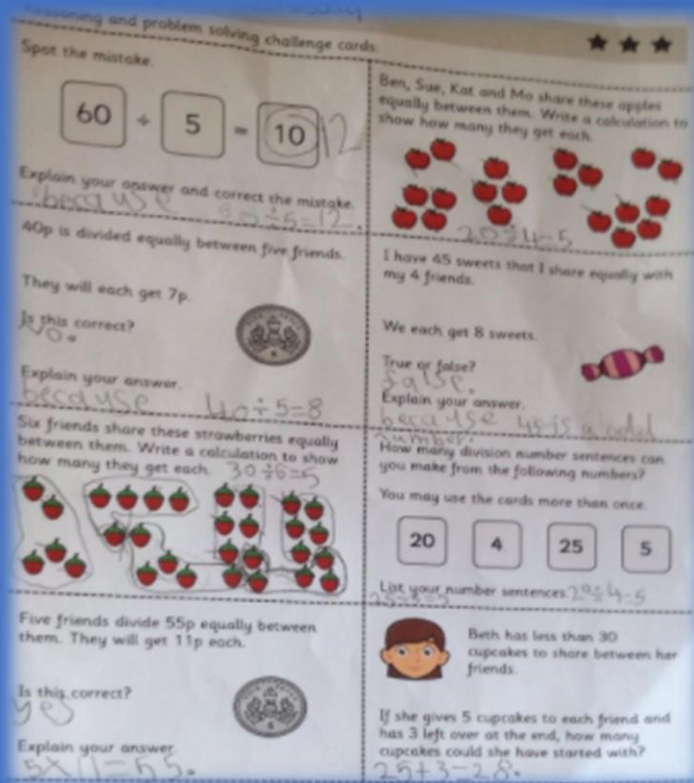
We are super proud of how well this boy is engaging with home learning. He's doing something everyday and it's super quality too.

Dissecting owl pellets to find out what it had eaten. Glad you're wearing gloves. Great science work.

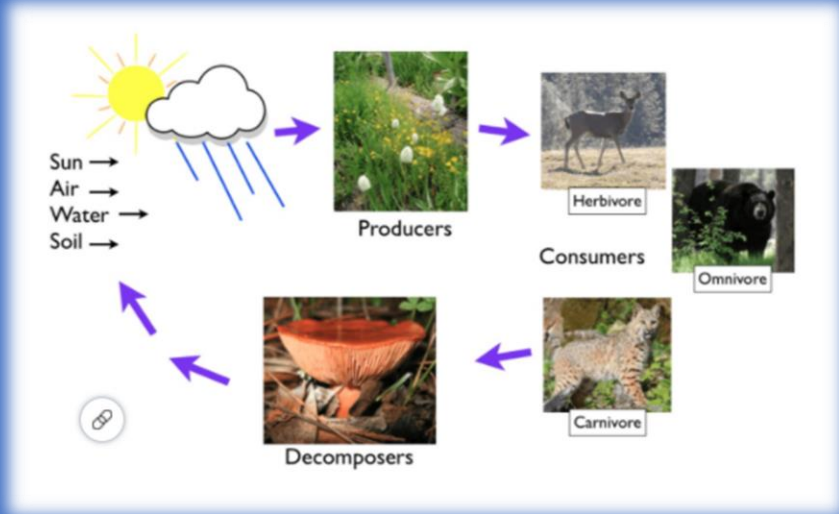




Outdoor counting.
