# Funky Fingers

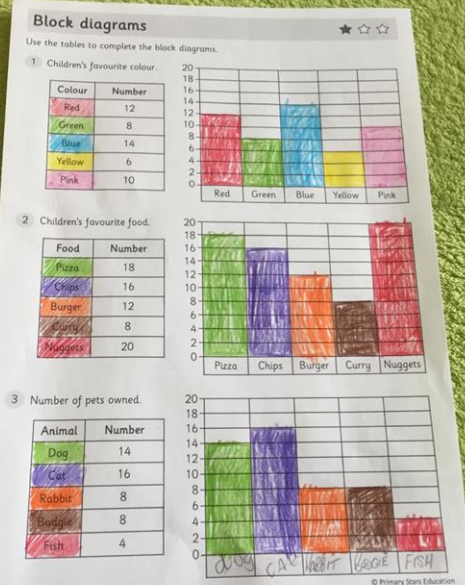
Charlie is giving his fingers a real workout.

Some lovely maths work on graphs from Mason this week. Nice to see your work on Seesaw buddy.

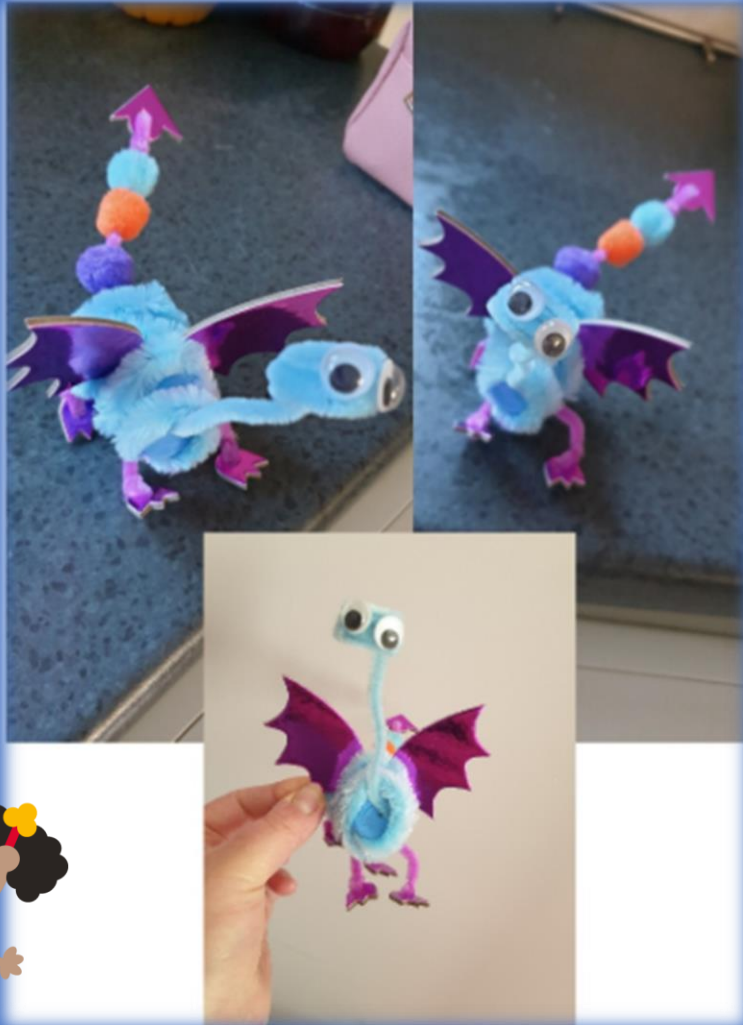






## Meet Ziggy

week. Well done Alfie.

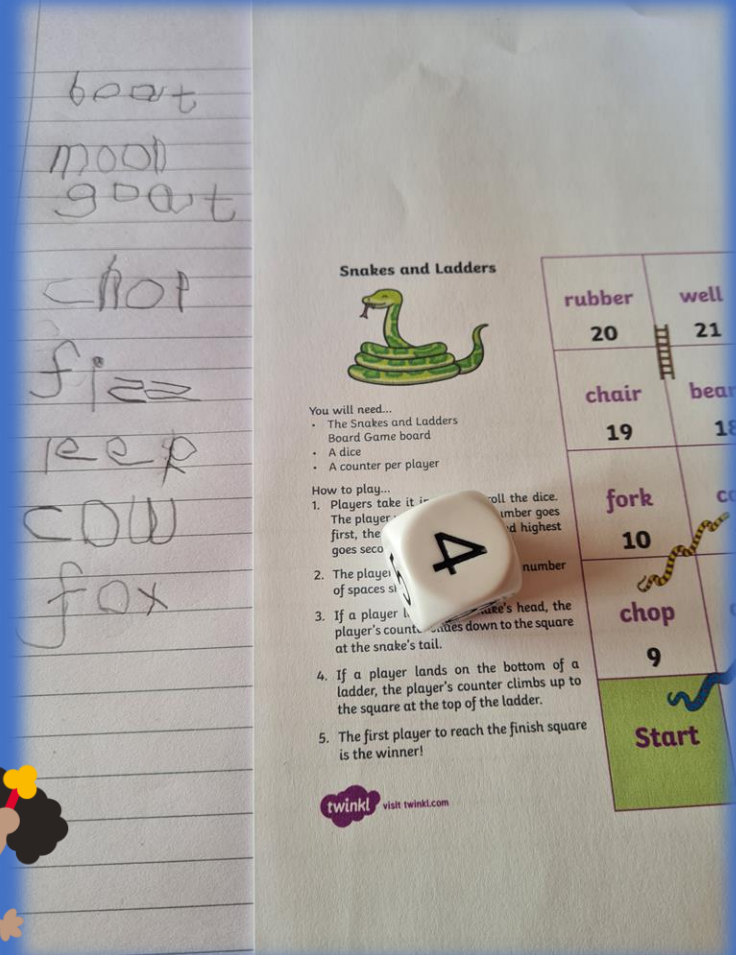






# A phonics game.
