Walk to School Week/Month (Sustrans Big Pedal 2021)	19 <sup>th</sup> April – 30 <sup>th</sup> April 2021	Healthier families; energised children; positive start to their day. Fewer cars being used therefore less traffic and parking around school. Less carbon emissions.
Park and Stride	Re-launch as part of the 10 day Active Challenge 19.4.21	Healthier families; energised children; positive start to their day. Fewer cars being used therefore less traffic and parking around school. Less carbon emissions.
Safe walking routes	Launch to parents and children 23 <sup>rd</sup> April 2021	By asking children to plot their current journey to school we will be encouraging parents and children to consider their routes carefully. This should lead to more uptake of children and parents walking/using the Park and Stride provision. These routes will be analysed by staff & pupils to use for further Active Travel activities and thereby maximising their involvement.
Road Safety Education	Summer Term 2021	Parents and children more confident to walk, scoot or cycle to school. Share educational DVD to raise awareness of how to use the crossings/road crossing patrol.
Bling your bike week	20 <sup>th</sup> April – 29 <sup>th</sup> April 2021	Children encouraged to use their bikes/scooters more by asking them to decorate and pedal into school for a grand parade. Children will develop their riding skills by completing a course on the playground.
Active Travel Diary	April 2021	Children encouraged to be more active at home or on way to school – post videos/photos on school platforms. Win prizes during Sustrans Big Pedal

Colour Wheel Challenge	20 <sup>th</sup> April 2021	Children encouraged to walk to school and record all of the different colours they see on the way.
Superhero Day	23 <sup>rd</sup> April 2021	Children will be learning about how active travel can be better for the environment.
A to Z Hunt	28 <sup>th</sup> April 2021	Children encouraged to walk to school using an 'I-spy' type hunt.
Let the Chalk do the Talk!	29 <sup>th</sup> April 2021	Children encouraged to walk to school by the incentive of drawing or writing a message in chalk on their walk into school.
Be Bright Be Seen Day	30 <sup>th</sup> April 2021	Children will learn about the safety aspects of high-viz clothing by encouraging them to dress up as brightly as possible. They will also learn about the health benefits of active travel in school.
