Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you've all had a wonderful summer and are looking forward to an exciting year ahead. We are really looking forward to working with you to ensure your child has a happy, productive and successful year.

P.E.

The children will have indoor P.E. on **Tuesdays** and outdoor P.E. on **Fridays** each week. Please make sure your child has a PE kit to change into in school. We will endeavour to go outside whatever the weather, so please ensure your child has appropriate clothing and footwear.

For safety reasons, children are not allowed to wear jewellery, including earrings, during P.E. lessons. Earrings must be removed on your child's P.E. days, as we are unfortunately unable to remove them on your behalf. Children will be unable to take part in the lesson if earrings are worn.

Reading in Class 5

Please send your child's book bag into school each day. When they arrive, we will ask them to place it in their classroom drawer.

We will listen to your child read once per week during guided reading sessions, and they will also take part in additional reading activities during daily phonics and shared reading lessons.

Throughout the week, your child will have opportunities to change their own reading books. Reading books to take home will be given out soon.

Autumn Term

The first 1–2 weeks will focus on settling in, learning how to use the classroom resources, and revisiting our school's Golden Rules. More information about the curriculum will be sent out next week.
